Earache

(Children aged 1 to 17 years)

Visit your Pharmacy First!

Getting a GP appointment is not always necessary, try pharmacy first for these conditions, especially when away from home.

When your child is ill with any of the above conditions, by going straight to a local pharmacy you can have a consultation with a trained clinical professional and receive advice and even medication if it is needed.

Did you know that pharmacies can now offer clinical appointments with medication available if required for four clinical conditions particularly relevant to school age children?

- Ear ache (children aged 1-17)
- Sore throat (over 5s)
- Infected insect bites (over 1s)
- Impetigo (over 1s)
