Please remember to book each activity by scanning the QR code — this helps us know who's coming along and ensures everything runs smoothly.

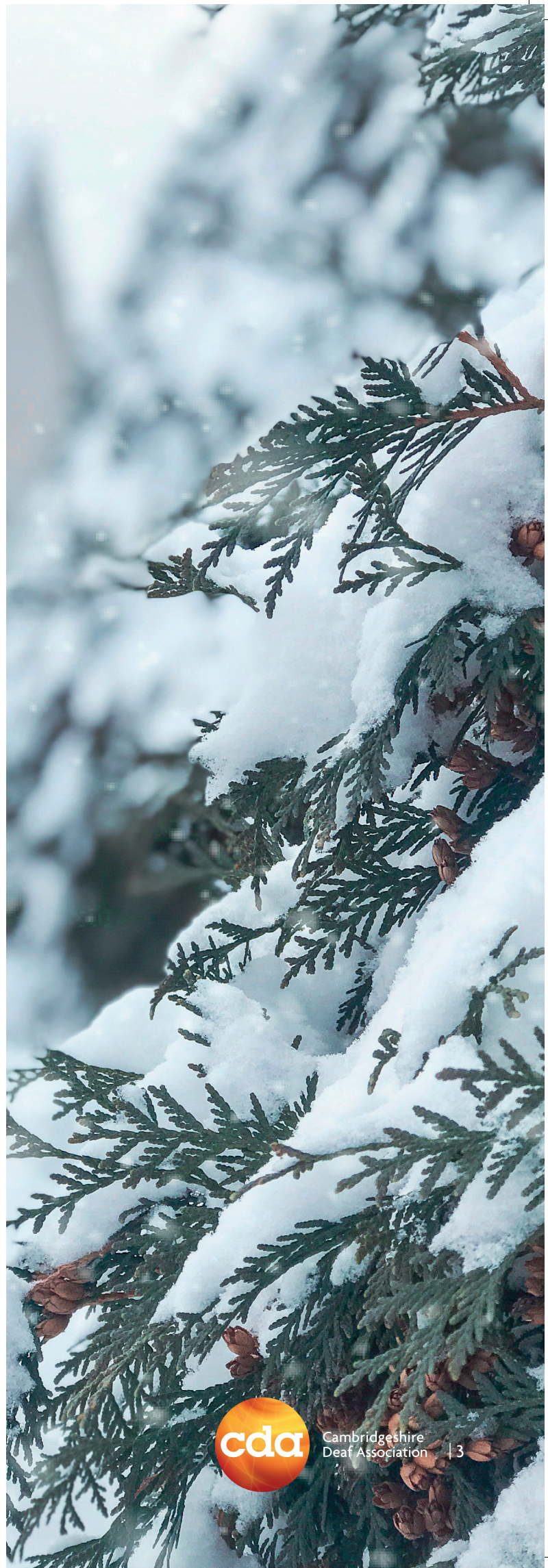
