I write to remind you that the above service became part of the national pharmacy contraception service as of 29th October 2025 and so this element of the contract between your organisation and Peterborough City Council automatically terminated on 31st October 2025.

Peterborough City Council would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the support you have given in delivering the above service.

Invoices in respect of EHC service activity up to and including 31st October 2025 can still be sent to us for payment.

The above service is now directly commissioned by NHSE, therefore, data on activity and invoices with effect from the 1st November 2025 need to be redirected through the national pharmacy contraception service payment route.

The Public Health Team looks forward to continuing working with those Pharmacies continuing to deliver Nicotine Replacement Therapy (NRT Voucher) Services.
